Tier-I Syllabus

1. General Intelligence & Reasoning:

- Analogies, Similarities and Differences, Spatial Visualization, Problem Solving, Decision Making, Visual Memory, Discrimination, Observation, Relationship Concepts, Arithmetical Reasoning, Verbal and Non-verbal Series, Coding-Decoding, Syllogism, etc.

2. General Awareness:

- Current Affairs, India and its Neighbouring Countries (History, Culture, Geography, Economic Scene, General Policy & Scientific Research), Static GK, etc.

3. Quantitative Aptitude:

- Whole Numbers, Decimals, Fractions, Percentages, Ratio & Proportion, Square Roots, Averages, Interest, Profit & Loss, Discount, Partnership, Time & Distance, Time & Work, Algebra, Geometry, Mensuration, Trigonometry, Statistics, etc.

4. English Comprehension:

- Vocabulary, Grammar, Sentence Structure, Synonyms, Antonyms, Comprehension, Spot the Error, Fill in the Blanks, Cloze Test, etc.

Tier-II Syllabus

Paper-I (Compulsory for all posts):

Section-I:

A. Mathematical Abilities - Number Systems, Algebra, Geometry, Trigonometry, Mensuration, Data Interpretation, etc.

B. Reasoning and General Intelligence - Similar topics as Tier-I with higher difficulty.

Section-II:

A. English Language and Comprehension - Grammar, Sentence Correction, Vocabulary, Reading Comprehension.

B. General Awareness - Current Events, Science, Polity, Economy, History, Geography, etc.

Section-III:

Computer Knowledge - Basics of Computers, Software, Hardware, Internet, MS Office.

Section-IV:

Data Entry Speed Test (DEST) - Typing test (2000 key depressions in 15 minutes).

Paper-II (Only for JSO & Statistical Investigator):

- Statistics - Collection, Classification & Presentation of Statistical Data, Measures of Central Tendency, Correlation and Regression, Probability Theory, Time Series Analysis, Index Numbers, etc.
